1 Enrolled, An Act,

3 Relating to Cherokee County; to authorize the Cherokee
4 County Commission to levy and provide for the collection of an
5 additional vehicle license and registration fee on each
6 vehicle license and registration, transfer, or renewal of any
7 vehicle in the county; and to provide for distribution of the
8 proceeds from the fees to the sheriff and the district
9 attorney.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1.(a) The Cherokee County Commission may levy
12 and provide for the collection of an additional vehicle
13 license and registration issuance fee in the amount of three
14 dollars and seventy-five cents (\$3.75) on each new
15 registration, transfer, or renewal on any vehicle in the
16 county. The Revenue Commissioner of the county or other
17 license issuing officials shall collect the issuance fee on
18 each new registration, transfer, or renewal on a vehicle in
19 the county. The fee shall be in addition to all other fees,
20 taxes, and other charges provided for the license and
21 registration of a vehicle.

22 (b) The proceeds from the additional issuance fees upon
23 collection shall be distributed on a monthly basis by the
24 Revenue Commissioner as follows:

25 (1) One dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) shall be
26 distributed to the District Attorney to be deposited in the
27 solicitor's fund. The proceeds from the fees shall be used for
28 law enforcement purposes and for the prosecution of crimes in

29 Cherokee County.

30 (2) Two dollars and twenty-five cents (\$2.25) shall be
31 distributed to the sheriff of the county to be deposited in
32 the Sheriff's Law Enforcement Fund. The proceeds from the fees
33 shall be used for law enforcement purposes.

34 (c) The proceeds from the fees and the use of the fees
35 shall not diminish or take the place of any other source of
36 funding of the District Attorney's office or sheriff's office
37 in the county.

38 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first
39 day of the third month following its passage and approval by
40 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
