8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would propose an amendment to the
9 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, relating to Mobile
10 County, to authorize the Legislature by local law
11 to levy an additional ad valorem tax on real
12 property in the unincorporated area of the county
13 included in county commission district one on the
14 date of the ratification of this amendment to be
15 distributed to qualified volunteer fire
16 departments.

22 To propose an amendment to the Constitution of
23 Alabama of 1901, relating to Mobile County, to authorize the
24 Legislature by local law to levy an additional ad valorem tax
25 on real property in the unincorporated area of the county
26 included in county commission district one on the date of the

1 ratification of this amendment to be distributed to qualified
2 volunteer fire departments.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

4 Section 1. The following amendment to the
5 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become
6 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of
7 this act are fulfilled:

8 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

9 The Legislature by local law applicable to Mobile
10 County may provide for the levy of an additional ad valorem
11 tax not to exceed one mill on all real property in the
12 unincorporated area of the county included in county
13 commission district one on the date of the ratification of
14 this amendment to be distributed to qualified volunteer fire
15 departments as provided in the local law.

16 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
17 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the
18 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section
19 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
20 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
21 state.

22 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
23 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
24 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
25 following description of the substance or subject matter of
26 the proposed constitutional amendment:

1 "Relating to Mobile County, proposing an amendment
2 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to authorize the
3 Legislature by local law to levy an additional ad valorem tax
4 on real property in the unincorporated area of the county
5 included in county commission district one on the date of the
6 ratification of this amendment to be distributed to qualified
7 volunteer fire departments.

8 "Proposed by Act _____"

9 This description shall be followed by the following
10 language:
