8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, the owner, operator, or
9 person responsible for the operation of a motor
10 vehicle cannot be held liable for any loss or
11 damage arising from injuries to or death of a guest
12 being transported in the motor vehicle unless the
13 owner, operator, or person responsible for the
14 operation of a motor vehicle receives payment for
15 the transportation or engages in willfull or wanton
16 misconduct.

17 This bill would repeal the existing law.

20 TO BE ENTITLED

21 AN ACT

22
23 To repeal Section 32-1-2, Code of Alabama 1975,
24 relating to motor vehicles and limiting liability for the
25 injury or death of a guest under certain conditions.

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1 Section 1. Section 32-1-2, Code of Alabama 1975, is
2 repealed.

3 Section 2. This act shall be prospective in
4 application and shall not affect or apply to any act or injury
5 occurring prior to the effective date of this act.

6 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
7 first day of the third month following its passage and
8 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
