4 SYNOPSIS:

> This bill would provide that in a Class 1 municipality, a student who transfers from one public K-12 school to another shall be enrolled in classes and may participate in activities, including athletic activities, in the same manner as all other students.

> This bill would also prohibit public K-12 schools in a Class 1 municipality from denying, or from being a member of any athletic association that denies, a student's participation in an athletic activity based on when he or she transferred to that school.

- 36 (c)(1) Beginning with the 2025-2026 school year, any
- 37 student who transfers from one school to another school shall
- 38 be enrolled in classes and may participate in activities,
- 39 including athletic activities, at the school to which he or
- 40 she transferred in the same manner as all other students
- 41 enrolled at that school.
- 42 (2) No public K-12 school may deny, nor be a member of
- 43 an athletic association that denies, student participation in
- 44 or eligibility for an athletic activity at the school where
- 45 the student is enrolled based on the date in which he or she
- 46 transferred to or enrolled in that school.
- 47 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
- 48 1, 2024.
