BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in accordance with Sections 284, 285 and 287 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

"PART I.

"The Except as provided in Part II of this section authorizing an Alabama Lottery, the Legislature shall have no power to authorize lotteries or gift enterprises for any purposes, and shall pass laws to prohibit the sale in this state of lottery or gift enterprise tickets, or tickets in any scheme in the nature of a lottery; and all acts, or parts of acts heretofore passed by the Legislature of this state, authorizing a lottery or lotteries, and all acts amendatory thereof, or supplemental thereto, are hereby avoided."

"PART II.

"(a) Authorization of an Alabama State Lottery.

1	"Notwithstanding Part I of this Section and the
2	existing and continued constitutional prohibitions on
3	lotteries and gift enterprises, there is authorized the
4	establishment of an Alabama Lottery restricted in its
5	operations to those activities authorized by this amendment.
6	"(b) Lottery Proceeds to General Fund.
7	"The proceeds from the Alabama Lottery shall be
8	applied first to the payment of the expenses of administering
9	and operating the Alabama Lottery by the Lottery Commission
10	and the payment of all prizes, without any further
11	appropriation required by law, and the balance of the proceeds
12	shall be deposited in the State General Fund for the ordinary
13	expenses of the executive, legislative, and judicial
14	departments of the state and for principal and interest
15	payments on the public debt.
16	"(c) Establishment of an Alabama State Lottery
17	Commission.
18	"There is further established an Alabama State
19	Lottery Commission, which shall function to administer and
20	regulate the Alabama Lottery. The Lottery Commission shall be
21	comprised of seven (7) members who will serve upon appointment
22	by the Governor to be confirmed by the Senate at the next
23	regular session.
24	"(d) Duty of the Legislature to Enact Implementing
25	Legislation.
26	"In accordance with the authorization of this Part
27	II, the Legislature shall enforce and implement this amendment

1	by passage of implementing legislation to provide for the	
2	administration, operation and regulation of the Alabama	
3	Lottery and for the duties and authorities of the Lottery	
4	Commission.	
5	"(e) Authorization of Activities.	
6	"The Alabama Lottery shall include only the sale of	
7	lottery tickets. The Lottery Commission may enter into	
8	reciprocal agreements with other jurisdictions for the	
9	operation and promotion of the activities authorized by this	
10	amendment.	
11	"(f) Effect of Amendment.	
12	"Nothing in this amendment affects, prohibits, or	
13	limits any activity which was legal at the time this amendment	
14	becomes effective, including, without limitation, pari-mutuel	
15	betting and nonprofit, traditional bingo, as provided for by	
16	specific law or laws. Further, nothing in this amendment	
17	authorizes any other activity beyond the Alabama Lottery	
18	authorized by this amendment.	
19	"The terms and provisions of this amendment shall	
20	supersede and take precedence over any other provision of the	
21	law which may conflict or be inconsistent with this

23	Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment	
24	shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the
