Such benefit, if not a multiple of one dollar 19 (\$1), shall be computed to the nearest multiple of one dollar (\$1). 20 "(b) With respect to weeks beginning prior to 21 22 January 1, 1989, each eligible individual shall be paid with 23 respect to such week as was provided in this section prior to

"(c) With respect to benefit years effective on or after the effective date of the act amending this section, an individual shall serve a one-week waiting period with no benefits payable during the first compensable week within a benefit year. The waiting week shall not be counted as a week of unemployment for the purposes of this section."

first day of the third month following its passage and
approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
