SB310 1 2 3 ENROLLED, An Act, 4 5 Relating to state, county, and municipal sales and use taxes; to amend Section 40-23-5 of the Code of Alabama 6 7 1975, to provide that the Birmingham Zoo, Inc., would be 8 exempt from payment of state, county, and municipal sales and 9 use taxes. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 10 11 Section 1. Section 40-23-5 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows: 12 13 "§40-23-5. "(a) The Diabetes Trust Fund, Inc., and any of its 14 15 branches or agencies, heretofore or hereafter organized and 16 existing in good faith in the State of Alabama for purposes 17 other than for pecuniary gain and not for individual profit, 18 are hereby exempted from paying any state, county or municipal 19 sales or use taxes. "(b) The Chilton County Rescue Squad is hereby 20 21 exempted from paying any sales or use taxes. 22 "(c) The state headquarters only of the American 23 Legion, the American Veterans of World War II, Korea and 24 Vietnam, also known as AMVETS, the Disabled American Veterans, 25 the Veterans of Foreign Wars, also known as VFW, Alabama

Goodwill Industries and the Alabama Sight Conservation
 Association are hereby exempted from paying any state, county
 or municipal sales or use taxes.

"(d) The Grand Chapter of all Orders of the Eastern 4 5 Star and the South Alabama State Fair Association Southeastern Livestock Exposition of the State of Alabama and any of its 6 7 agencies, heretofore or hereafter organized and existing in 8 good faith in the State of Alabama for purposes other than for pecuniary gain and not for individual profit, are hereby 9 10 exempted from paying any state, county or municipal sales and 11 use taxes.

"(e) The Alabama Goodwill Industries, Inc., of
Birmingham is hereby exempted from paying any state,
municipal, or county sales and use taxes.

15 "(f) The Alabama Federation of Women's Clubs is 16 hereby exempted from paying any state, county or municipal 17 sales or use taxes.

18 "(g) The National Conference of State Legislatures 19 and the Council of State Governments are hereby exempted from 20 paying any state, county or municipal sales or use taxes.

"(h) All blind vendors associated with the Business
Enterprise Program of the Department of Rehabilitation
Services are hereby exempted from paying any state, county or
municipal sales or use taxes.

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"(i) All vendors who are blind as defined by Section 1 1-1-3, and who are certified by the Department of 2 3 Rehabilitation Services, are hereby exempted from paying any state, county or municipal sales or use taxes. 4 5 "(j) The Elks Club, B.P.O.E., No. 1887, a corporation, is hereby exempted from paying any state, county 6 or municipal sales or use taxes. Provided, however, that the 7 8 exemption provided by this subsection shall not extend to any bar or dining room operation conducted by said Elks Club. 9 "(k) The King's Ranch, Inc., is hereby exempted from 10 11 paying any state, county or municipal sales or use taxes. 12 "(1) The Eye Foundation, Inc., and any of its 13 branches or agencies, heretofore, or hereafter organized and 14 existing in good faith in the State of Alabama for purposes 15 other than for pecuniary gain and not for individual profit, 16 are hereby exempted from paying any state, county, or 17 municipal sales or use taxes. 18 "(m) Any county public hospital association or any 19 Alabama nonprofit membership corporation if one or more of its members is a county public hospital association, and any of 20 its, or their, branches, agencies, lessees or successors 21 22 organized pursuant to Section 10-3A-1 et seq., and which 23 operates or maintains hospitals for purposes other than for pecuniary gain and not for individual profit, is hereby 24 25 exempted from paying any state, county, or municipal sales and

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use tax of any nature whatsoever. Any of the taxes which were 1 2 or may be assessed or collected subsequent to December 31, 3 1993, against any Alabama nonprofit membership corporation or any lessee of any county public hospital association organized 4 5 as herein stated, pursuant to a lease in writing, will be 6 remitted to the entity which paid them; and no action or proceeding against the association or nonprofit corporation 7 8 may be instituted after the date by the State of Alabama or 9 any county or municipality thereof or any agent or person acting on behalf thereof for the collection or enforcement of 10 any sales or use tax of any nature whatsoever. 11

"(n) There is hereby exempted from all state, county 12 13 and municipal sales taxes the sale of food pursuant to the 14 food distribution program conducted by Christian Service 15 Mission, Inc., an Alabama not-for-profit corporation, in 16 cooperation with World Share, Inc., to enable needy persons to 17 purchase food at substantially discounted prices and in 18 consideration of the performance of charitable or community 19 work by such persons.

"(o) Rescue service organizations operating within the State of Alabama which are exempt from federal income taxes under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, §501(c)(3) and which are members of the Alabama Rescue Services Association, Incorporated, are hereby exempted from any state, county and municipal sales and use taxes.

"(p) Alabama Goodwill Industries, Inc., Goodwill 1 Industries of Mobile Area, Inc., and Goodwill Industries of 2 3 Central Alabama, Inc., are exempted from paying any state, county, and municipal sales or use taxes. 4 5 "(q) The gross receipts from the sale of admissions to a sporting event conducted by the Senior Professional 6 Golfers Association are exempted from any state, county, and 7 8 municipal sales taxes. "(r) Volunteer, non-profit rescue units operating 9 within the state which do not meet the criteria in subsection 10 (o) but are licensed by the State Board of Health are exempt 11 from any state, county, and municipal sales and use taxes. 12 13 "(s) The Birmingham Zoo, Inc., is exempt from paying any state, county, and municipal sales and use taxes 14 15 associated with any and all capital expenditures but shall 16 continue to collect and remit all other taxes to the 17 appropriate taxing authorities." 18 Section 2. The exemption provided pursuant to 19 subsection(s) of Section 40-23-5 shall no longer be available four years after the effective date of this bill. 20 21 Section 3. The Birmingham Zoo, Inc. shall report 22 annually to the Department of Revenue on the sales for which 23 the exemption is granted. The Department of Revenue shall 24 prescribe the format of such annual report.

Section 4. This act shall become effective on the
 first day of the third month following its passage and
 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
