"(3) TUITION. The cost of instruction and fees to the student as stated in the institution's catalog, plus the average cost of books and supplies, to a minimum of one hundred dollars (\$100) per semester, and not to exceed 50 percent of the remaining balance one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per semester after all federal benefits have been applied to the account of the student, for a total amount not exceeding two thousand dollars (\$2,000) annually.

"(4) VETERAN. Any person with more than 180 days active duty under Title 10, United States Code, annotated, and entitled to federal educational benefits will be considered a veteran and not eligible for benefits under this article.

"(5) WORDS IMPORTING THE MASCULINE GENDER ONLY.

"The Alabama Commission on Higher Education is hereby authorized to pay or reimburse the tuition for any active member of the Alabama National Guard who is enrolled in a program leading to the associate, baccalaureate, masters, or doctorate degree in an accredited institution of higher learning, technical college, or junior college within the State of Alabama. To be eligible for such benefits, the individual, at the time of his or her enrollment must be a member of the Alabama National Guard in good standing and a

member of a federally recognized unit of the Alabama National 1 2 Guard. The member must be at least 17 years of age and must be a resident of the State of Alabama. The tuition grant 3 authorized under this article may be used for undergraduate or graduate studies. In no event will any individual be eligible to receive more than 100 percent of covered expenses when 6 combined with similar federal veterans' educational benefits 7 8 available to members of the National Guard. All applicants for a tuition grant shall complete a Free Application for Student 9 10 Financial Aid (FAFSA). No person shall be eligible for a 11 tuition grant for more than 12 years after the date of the 12 first tuition payment to him or her under this article. For 13 degrees above the baccalaureate, only 10 percent of the total 14 funds of the benefit program are to be utilized. The Alabama 15 Commission on Higher Education shall set up minimum standards 16 for performance that must be met in order to maintain 17 eligibility for the continuation of the receipt of tuition 18 grants under this article." 19 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 20 first day of the third month following its passage and

approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
