4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 To add Section 15-22-1.3 to the Code of Alabama
6 1975, relating to the Interstate Compact for Adult Offender
7 Supervision; to require an interstate transfer application fee
8 for each application prepared for an offender; to provide for
9 distribution of the fees; and to provide exemptions.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1. Section 15-22-1.3 is added to the Code of
12 Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

13 §15-22-1.3.

14 (a) Any adult offender placed under community
15 supervision and released to the community under the
16 jurisdiction of the courts, paroling authorities, corrections,
17 or other criminal justice agencies filing a written request to
18 transfer residence from this state to another state under the
19 Interstate Compact for the Supervision of Adult Offenders
20 shall pay a transfer application fee of seventy-five dollars
21 (\$75) for each application prepared for the offender. An
22 exemption from the transfer application fee under this
23 subsection may be granted by the Board of Pardons and Paroles
24 for undue hardship on a case-by-case basis upon the written
25 request of the offender making an application for transfer.

1 (b) The proceeds of the application fees collected
2 pursuant to subsection (a) shall be deposited into the State
3 Treasury to the credit of the Probationer's Upkeep Fund. The
4 funds are hereby continuously appropriated to the Board of
5 Pardons and Paroles.

6 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
7 first day of the third month following its passage and
8 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
