Relating to the Administrative Office of Courts; to require quarterly reporting by the Administrative Director of Courts containing the total amount of court costs, docket fees, fines, and other fees that each court waived or remitted during the quarter.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The Administrative Director of Courts shall provide a report at the end of each quarter of the fiscal year for each circuit and district court containing a complete accounting of all court costs, docket fees, fines, any other fees due to the court, and any other fees the Administrative Director of Courts deems appropriate that were waived or remitted by the court during the quarterly reporting period. The quarterly report shall provide the total number of cases in which such amounts were waived or remitted, as well as the total amount waived or remitted, for all civil and

criminal cases, including traffic cases, for each circuit and 1 2 district court. The quarterly report shall provide this information based on the type of case in which such amounts 3 were waived or remitted. The Administrative Director of Courts 4 5 shall submit such reports to the Chairs of the Senate Committee on Finance and Taxation General Fund and the House 6 7 Ways and Means General Fund Committee, the Legislative Fiscal 8 Officer, and the State Budget Officer. 9 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 10 October 1, 2014 following its passage and approval by the

Governor or its otherwise becoming law.
