27	confidentiality nature or integrity of the work or the

product sought. For purposes of this act, open source software

that software that the end-user licensing agreement allows

a user to modify and distribute the software, as opposed to

proprietary software that typically prohibits reverse

engineering.

(b) The Finance Department shall promulgate rules and regulations to implement and administer this act.
