4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 Relating to opioids; to amend Sections 13A-12-211,  
6 13A-12-231, Code of Alabama 1975, to provide enhanced criminal  
7 penalties for the unlawful possession or unlawful  
8 distribution, Fentanyl, and certain synthetic controlled  
9 substance analogues; to provide criminal penalties for the  
10 unlawful trafficking of Fentanyl or any synthetic controlled  
11 substance Fentanyl analogue added to Schedule I; to provide an  
12 alternative method for charging a person for trafficking of  
13 certain controlled substances or analogues; to amend Section  
14 20-2-23, Code of Alabama 1975, to add certain named chemical  
15 compounds of Fentanyl and synthetic controlled substance  
16 Fentanyl analogues, to Schedule I of the controlled substances  
17 list; and in connection therewith would have as its purpose or  
18 effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of  
19 local funds within the meaning of Amendment 621 of the  
20 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section  
21 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of  
22 Alabama of 1901, as amended.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1           Section 1. Sections 13A-12-211, 13A-12-231, and  
2 Section 20-2-23, Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:

3           "§13A-12-211.

4           "(a) A person commits the crime of unlawful  
5 distribution of controlled substances if, except as otherwise  
6 authorized, he or she sells, furnishes, gives away, delivers,  
7 or distributes a controlled substance enumerated in Schedules  
8 I through V.

9           "(b) Unlawful distribution of controlled substances  
10 is a Class B felony.

11           "(c) A person commits the crime of unlawful  
12 possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance  
13 if, except as otherwise authorized by law, he or she knowingly  
14 possesses any of the following quantities of a controlled  
15 substance:

16           "(1) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams,  
17 of cocaine or of any mixture containing cocaine.

18           "(2) More than two grams, but less than four grams,  
19 of any mixture of morphine, opium, or any salt, isomer, or  
20 salt of an isomer thereof, including heroin or any mixture  
21 containing Fentanyl or any synthetic controlled substance  
22 Fentanyl or any synthetic controlled substance Fentanyl  
23 analogue, as described in Sections 20-2-23 and 20-2-25.

1           "(3) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams,  
2 of 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or of any mixture  
3 containing 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine.

4           "(4) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams,  
5 of 5-methoxy-3, 4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or of any  
6 mixture containing 5-methoxy-3, 4-methylenedioxy amphetamine.

7           "(5) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams,  
8 of amphetamine or any mixture containing amphetamine, its  
9 salt, optical isomer, or salt of its optical isomer thereof.

10           "(6) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams,  
11 of methamphetamine or any mixture containing methamphetamine,  
12 its salts, optical isomers, or salt of its optical isomers  
13 thereof.

14           "(7) More than one-half gram, but less than one  
15 gram, of Fentanyl or any synthetic controlled substance  
16 Fentanyl analogue, as a single component.

17           "(d) Unlawful possession with intent to distribute a  
18 controlled substance is a Class B felony.

19           "§13A-12-231.

20           "Except as authorized in Chapter 2, Title 20:

21           "(1) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,  
22 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in  
23 actual or constructive possession of, in excess of one kilo or  
24 2.2 pounds of any part of the plant of the genus Cannabis,  
25 whether growing or not, the seeds thereof, the resin extracted

1 from any part of the plant, and every compound, manufacture,  
2 salt, derivative, mixture, or preparation of the plant, its  
3 seeds, or resin including the completely defoliated mature  
4 stalks of the plant, fiber produced from the stalks, oil, or  
5 cake, or the completely sterilized samples of seeds of the  
6 plant which are incapable of germination is guilty of a  
7 felony, which felony shall be known as "trafficking in  
8 cannabis." Nothing in this subdivision shall apply to samples  
9 of tetrahydrocannabinols including, but not limited to, all  
10 synthetic or naturally produced samples of  
11 tetrahydrocannabinols which contain more than 15 percent by  
12 weight of tetrahydrocannabinols and which do not contain plant  
13 material exhibiting the external morphological features of the  
14 plant cannabis. If the quantity of cannabis involved:

15 "a. Is in excess of one kilo or 2.2 pounds, but less  
16 than 100 pounds, the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory  
17 minimum term of imprisonment of three calendar years and to  
18 pay a fine of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000).

19 "b. Is 100 pounds or more, but less than 500 pounds,  
20 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
21 imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of fifty  
22 thousand dollars (\$50,000).

23 "c. Is 500 pounds or more, but less than 1,000  
24 pounds, the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum

1 term of imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of  
2 two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000).

3 "d. Is 1,000 pounds or more, the person shall be  
4 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~  
5 ~~parole~~.

6 "(2) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,  
7 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in  
8 actual or constructive possession of, 28 grams or more of  
9 cocaine or of any mixture containing cocaine, described in  
10 Section 20-2-25(1), is guilty of a felony, which felony shall  
11 be known as "trafficking in cocaine." If the quantity  
12 involved:

13 "a. Is 28 grams or more, but less than 500 grams,  
14 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
15 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of  
16 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

17 "b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than one kilo,  
18 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
19 imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of one  
20 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

21 "c. Is one kilo, but less than 10 kilos, then the  
22 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
23 imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of two  
24 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).

1           "d. Is 10 kilos or more, the person shall be  
2 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~  
3 ~~parole~~.

4           "(3) Any person, except as otherwise authorized by  
5 law, who knowingly sells, manufactures, delivers, or brings  
6 into this state, or who is knowingly in actual or constructive  
7 possession of, four grams or more of any morphine, opium, or  
8 any salt, isomer, or salt of an isomer thereof, including  
9 heroin, as described in Section 20-2-23(b) (2) or Section  
10 20-2-25(1)a., or four grams or more of any mixture containing  
11 any such substance, or any mixture containing Fentanyl or any  
12 synthetic controlled substance Fentanyl analogue, as described  
13 in Sections 20-2-23 and 20-2-25, is guilty of a felony, which  
14 felony shall be known as "trafficking in illegal drugs." If  
15 the quantity involved:

16           "a. Is four grams or more, but less than 14 grams,  
17 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
18 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of  
19 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

20           "b. Is 14 grams or more, but less than 28 grams, the  
21 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
22 imprisonment of 10 calendar years and to pay a fine of one  
23 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

24           "c. Is 28 grams or more, but less than 56 grams, the  
25 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of

1 imprisonment of 25 calendar years and to pay a fine of five  
2 hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000).

3 "d. Is 56 grams or more, the person shall be  
4 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~  
5 ~~parole~~.

6 "(4) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,  
7 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in  
8 actual or constructive possession of 1,000 or more pills or  
9 capsules of methaqualone, as described in Section 20-2-1, et  
10 seq., is guilty of a felony, which felony shall be known as  
11 "trafficking in illegal drugs." If the quantity involved:

12 "a. Is 1,000 pills or capsules, but less than 5,000  
13 pills or capsules, the person shall be sentenced to a  
14 mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of three calendar years  
15 and pay a fine of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

16 "b. Is 5,000 capsules or more, but less than 25,000  
17 capsules, that person shall be imprisoned to a mandatory  
18 minimum term of imprisonment of 10 calendar years and pay a  
19 fine of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

20 "c. Is 25,000 pills or more, but less than 100,000  
21 pills or capsules, the person shall be sentenced to a  
22 mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of 25 calendar years  
23 and pay a fine of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000).



1           "d. Is 100,000 capsules or more, the person shall be  
2 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~  
3 ~~parole~~.

4           "(5) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,  
5 delivers or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in  
6 actual or constructive possession of 500 or more pills or  
7 capsules of hydromorphone as is described in Section 20-2-1,  
8 et seq., is guilty of a felony which shall be known as  
9 "trafficking in illegal drugs." If the quantity involved:

10           "a. Is 500 pills or capsules or more but less than  
11 1,000 pills or capsules, the person shall be sentenced to a  
12 mandatory term of imprisonment of three calendar years and to  
13 pay a fine of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

14           "b. Is 1,000 pills or capsules or more, but less  
15 than 4,000 pills or capsules, the person shall be sentenced to  
16 a mandatory term of imprisonment of 10 calendar years and to  
17 pay a fine of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

18           "c. Is 4,000 pills or capsules or more but less than  
19 10,000 pills or capsules, the person shall be sentenced to a  
20 mandatory term of imprisonment of 25 calendar years and to pay  
21 a fine of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

22           "d. Is more than 10,000 pills or capsules, the  
23 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory term of life ~~in~~  
24 ~~prison without parole~~.

1           "(6) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,  
2 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in  
3 actual or constructive possession of, 28 grams or more of  
4 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or of any mixture containing  
5 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, is guilty of a felony, which  
6 felony shall be known as "trafficking in illegal drugs." If  
7 the quantity involved:

8           "a. Is 28 grams or more, but less than 500 grams,  
9 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
10 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of  
11 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

12           "b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than one kilo,  
13 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
14 imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of one  
15 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

16           "c. Is one kilo, but less than 10 kilos, then the  
17 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
18 imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of two  
19 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).

20           "d. Is 10 kilos or more, the person shall be  
21 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~  
22 ~~parole~~.

23           "(7) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,  
24 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in  
25 actual or constructive possession of, 28 grams or more of

1 5-methoxy-3, 4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or of any mixture  
2 containing 5-methoxy-3, 4-methylenedioxy amphetamine is guilty  
3 of a felony, which felony shall be known as "trafficking in  
4 illegal drugs" if the quantity involved:

5 "a. Is 28 grams or more, but less than 500 grams,  
6 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
7 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of  
8 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

9 "b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than one kilo,  
10 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
11 imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of one  
12 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

13 "c. Is one kilo, but less than 10 kilos, then the  
14 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
15 imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of two  
16 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).

17 "d. Is 10 kilos or more, the person shall be  
18 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~  
19 ~~parole~~.

20 "(8) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,  
21 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in  
22 actual or constructive possession of, four grams or more of  
23 phencyclidine, or any mixture containing phencyclidine, is  
24 guilty of a felony, which felony shall be known as  
25 "trafficking in illegal drugs." If the quantity involved:

1            "a. Is four grams or more, but less than 14 grams,  
2 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
3 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of  
4 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

5            "b. Is 14 grams or more, but less than 28 grams, the  
6 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
7 imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of one  
8 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

9            "c. Is 28 grams or more, but less than 56 grams,  
10 then the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term  
11 of imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of two  
12 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).

13           "d. Is 56 grams or more, the person shall be  
14 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~  
15 ~~parole~~.

16           "(9) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,  
17 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in  
18 actual or constructive possession of, four grams or more of  
19 lysergic acid diethylamide, of four grams or more of any  
20 mixture containing lysergic acid diethylamide, is guilty of a  
21 felony, which felony shall be known as "trafficking in illegal  
22 drugs." If the quantity involved:

23           "a. Is four grams or more, but less than 14 grams,  
24 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of

1 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of  
2 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

3 "b. Is 14 grams or more, but less than 28 grams, the  
4 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
5 imprisonment of 10 calendar years and to pay a fine of one  
6 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

7 "c. Is 28 grams or more, but less than 56 grams, the  
8 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
9 imprisonment of 25 calendar years and to pay a fine of five  
10 hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000).

11 "d. Is 56 grams or more, the person shall be  
12 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~  
13 ~~parole~~.

14 "(10) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,  
15 delivers or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in  
16 actual or constructive possession of, 28 grams or more of  
17 amphetamine or any mixture containing amphetamine, its salt,  
18 optical isomer, or salt of its optical isomer thereof, is  
19 guilty of a felony, which felony shall be known as  
20 "trafficking in amphetamine." If the quantity involved:

21 "a. Is 28 grams or more but less than 500 grams, the  
22 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
23 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of  
24 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

1            "b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than one kilo,  
2 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
3 imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of one  
4 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

5            "c. Is one kilo but less than 10 kilos, then the  
6 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
7 imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of two  
8 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).

9            "d. Is 10 kilos or more, the person shall be  
10 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~  
11 ~~parole~~.

12            "(11) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,  
13 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in  
14 actual or constructive possession of, 28 grams or more of  
15 methamphetamine or any mixture containing methamphetamine, its  
16 salts, optical isomers, or salt of its optical isomers  
17 thereof, is guilty of a felony, which felony shall be known as  
18 "trafficking in methamphetamine." If the quantity involved:

19            "a. Is 28 grams or more but less than 500 grams, the  
20 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
21 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of  
22 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

23            "b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than one kilo,  
24 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of

1 imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of one  
2 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

3 "c. Is one kilo but less than 10 kilos, then the  
4 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
5 imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of two  
6 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).

7 "d. Is 10 kilos or more, the person shall be  
8 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~  
9 ~~parole~~.

10 "(12) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,  
11 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in  
12 actual or constructive possession of 56 or more grams of a  
13 synthetic controlled substance or a synthetic controlled  
14 substance analogue, as described in subdivision (4) or (5) of  
15 subsection (a) of Section 20-2-23, except for any synthetic  
16 controlled substance Fentanyl analogue referenced in  
17 subdivisions (13), is guilty of a felony, which felony shall  
18 be known as "trafficking in synthetic controlled substances."  
19 If the quantity involved:

20 "a. Is 56 grams or more, but less than 500 grams,  
21 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
22 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of  
23 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

24 "b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than 1 kilo, the  
25 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of

1 imprisonment of 10 calendar years and to pay a fine of one  
2 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

3 "c. Is one kilo, but less than 10 kilos, then the  
4 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of  
5 imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of two  
6 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).

7 "d. Is 10 kilos or more, the person shall be  
8 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life ~~without~~  
9 ~~parole~~.

10 "(13) Any person, unless otherwise authorized by  
11 law, who knowingly sells, manufactures, delivers, or brings  
12 into this state, or who is knowingly in actual or constructive  
13 possession of, one gram or more of Fentanyl or any synthetic  
14 controlled substance Fentanyl analogue, as a single component  
15 as described in Sections 20-2-23 and 20-2-25, is guilty of a  
16 felony, which felony shall be known as "trafficking in illegal  
17 drugs." If the quantity involved:

18 "a. Is one gram or more, but less than two grams,  
19 the person shall be ordered to pay a minimum fine of fifty  
20 thousand dollars (\$50,000).

21 "b. Is two grams or more, but less than four grams,  
22 the person shall be ordered to pay a minimum fine of one  
23 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).



1           "c. Is four grams or more, but less than eight  
2 grams, the person shall be ordered to pay a minimum fine of  
3 five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000).

4           "d. Is eight grams or more, the person shall be  
5 ordered to pay a minimum fine of seven hundred fifty thousand  
6 dollars (\$750,000).

7           "(14) In lieu of the weight ranges listed in  
8 subdivision (12), a person may instead be charged with  
9 trafficking any substance listed in subdivisions (3) and (12)  
10 if that person possesses 50 or more individual packages of  
11 that substance. The person shall only be sentenced according  
12 to the sentence range provision listed in paragraph a. of each  
13 subdivision for the specific substance contained in the 50 or  
14 more individual packages if charged pursuant to this  
15 subdivision, subdivision (15), or subdivision (16), if  
16 applicable. In order to charge a person pursuant to this  
17 subdivision, the same substance must be contained in each of  
18 the 50 or more individual packages.

19           ~~"(13)~~ (15) The felonies of "trafficking in  
20 cannabis," "trafficking in cocaine," "trafficking in illegal  
21 drugs," "trafficking in amphetamine," "trafficking in  
22 methamphetamine," and "trafficking in synthetic controlled  
23 substances" as defined in subdivisions (1) through ~~(12)~~ (14),  
24 above, shall be treated as Class A felonies for purposes of  
25 Title 13A, including sentencing under Section 13A-5-9.

1 Provided, however, that the sentence of imprisonment for a  
2 defendant with one or more prior felony convictions who  
3 violates subdivisions (1) through ~~(12)~~ (14) of this section  
4 shall be the sentence provided therein, or the sentence  
5 provided under Section 13A-5-9, whichever is greater. Provided  
6 further, that the fine for a defendant with one or more prior  
7 felony convictions who violates subdivisions (1) through ~~(12)~~  
8 (14) of this section shall be the fine provided therein, or  
9 the fine provided under Section 13A-5-9, whichever is greater.

10 "~~(14)~~ (16) Notwithstanding any provision of law to  
11 the contrary, any person who has possession of a firearm  
12 during the commission of any act proscribed by this section  
13 shall be punished by a term of imprisonment of five calendar  
14 years which shall be in addition to, and not in lieu of, the  
15 punishment otherwise provided, and a fine of twenty-five  
16 thousand dollars (\$25,000); the court shall not suspend the  
17 five-year additional sentence of the person or give the person  
18 a probationary sentence.

19 "§20-2-23.

20 "(a) The Legislature finds the following:

21 "(1) New synthetic substances are being created  
22 which are not controlled under the provisions of existing  
23 state law but which have a potential for abuse similar to or  
24 greater than that for substances controlled under existing  
25 state law. These new synthetic substances are called

1 "synthetic controlled substances or synthetic controlled  
2 substance analogues" and can be designed to produce a desired  
3 pharmacological effect and to evade the controlling statutory  
4 provisions. Synthetic controlled substances or synthetic  
5 controlled substance analogues are being manufactured,  
6 distributed, possessed, and used as substitutes for controlled  
7 substances.

8 "(2) The hazards attributable to the traffic in and  
9 use of a synthetic controlled substance or synthetic  
10 controlled substance analogues are increased because their  
11 unregulated manufacture produces variations in purity and  
12 concentration.

13 "(3) Many new synthetic substances are untested, and  
14 it cannot be immediately determined whether they have useful  
15 medical or chemical purposes.

16 "(4) The uncontrolled importation, manufacture,  
17 distribution, possession, or use of controlled substance  
18 analogues has a substantial and detrimental impact on the  
19 health and safety of the people of this state.

20 "(5) Synthetic controlled substances or synthetic  
21 controlled substance analogues can be created more rapidly  
22 than they can be identified and controlled by action of the  
23 Legislature. There is a need for a speedy determination of  
24 their proper classification under existing law. It is  
25 therefore necessary to identify and classify new substances

1 that have a potential for abuse, so that they can be  
2 controlled in the same manner as other substances controlled  
3 under existing state law.

4 "(b) The controlled substances listed in this  
5 section are included in Schedule I:

6 "(1) Any of the following opiates, including their  
7 isomers, esters, ethers, salts, and salts of isomers, esters  
8 and ethers, unless specifically excepted, whenever the  
9 existence of these isomers, esters, ethers and salts is  
10 possible within the specific chemical designation:

- 11 "a. Acetylmethadol;
- 12 "b. Allylprodine;
- 13 "c. Alphacetylmethadol;
- 14 "d. Alphameprodine;
- 15 "e. Alphamethadol;
- 16 "f. Benzethidine;
- 17 "g. Betacetylmethadol;
- 18 "h. Betameprodine;

3 Section 2. The amendatory language in this act shall  
4 only apply to offenses occurring on or after the effective

6 Section 3. Although this bill would have as its  
7 purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased  
8 expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further  
9 requirements and application under Amendment 621, now  
10 appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of  
11 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the  
12 bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an  
13 existing crime.

14 Section 4. This act shall become effective  
15 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
16 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
