Relating to opioids; to amend Sections 13A-12-211, 5 6 13A-12-231, Code of Alabama 1975, to provide enhanced criminal 7 penalties for the unlawful possession or unlawful 8 distribution, Fentanyl, and certain synthetic controlled 9 substance analogues; to provide criminal penalties for the 10 unlawful trafficking of Fentanyl or any synthetic controlled 11 substance Fentanyl analogue added to Schedule I; to provide an 12 alternative method for charging a person for trafficking of 13 certain controlled substances or analogues; to amend Section 14 20-2-23, Code of Alabama 1975, to add certain named chemical 15 compounds of Fentanyl and synthetic controlled substance 16 Fentanyl analogues, to Schedule I of the controlled substances 17 list; and in connection therewith would have as its purpose or 18 effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of 19 local funds within the meaning of Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 20 21 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended. 22

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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1	Section 1. Sections 13A-12-211, 13A-12-231, and
2	Section 20-2-23, Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:

5	distribution of controlled substances if, except as otherwise

13	if, except as otherwise authorized by law, he or she knowingly

1 "(3) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams, 2 of 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or of any mixture containing 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine. 3 "(4) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams, 4 of 5-methoxy-3, 4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or of any 5 6 mixture containing 5-methoxy-3, 4-methylenedioxy amphetamine. 7 "(5) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams, 8 of amphetamine or any mixture containing amphetamine, its salt, optical isomer, or salt of its optical isomer thereof. 9 "(6) More than eight grams, but less than 28 grams, 10 11 of methamphetamine or any mixture containing methamphetamine, its salts, optical isomers, or salt of its optical isomers 12 13 thereof. 14 "(7) More than one-half gram, but less than one gram, of Fentanyl or any synthetic controlled substance 15 16 Fentanyl analogue, as a single component. 17 "(d) Unlawful possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance is a Class B felony. 18 "§13A-12-231. 19 "Except as authorized in Chapter 2, Title 20: 20 21 "(1) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures, 22 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in actual or constructive possession of, in excess of one kilo or 23 24 2.2 pounds of any part of the plant of the genus Cannabis, whether growing or not, the seeds thereof, the resin extracted 25

1 from any part of the plant, and every compound, manufacture, 2 salt, derivative, mixture, or preparation of the plant, its 3 seeds, or resin including the completely defoliated mature stalks of the plant, fiber produced from the stalks, oil, or 4 5 cake, or the completely sterilized samples of seeds of the 6 plant which are incapable of germination is guilty of a 7 felony, which felony shall be known as "trafficking in 8 cannabis." Nothing in this subdivision shall apply to samples of tetrahydrocannabinols including, but not limited to, all 9 10 synthetic or naturally produced samples of 11 tetrahydrocannabinols which contain more than 15 percent by 12 weight of tetrahydrocannabinols and which do not contain plant 13 material exhibiting the external morphological features of the 14 plant cannabis. If the quantity of cannabis involved:

"a. Is in excess of one kilo or 2.2 pounds, but less than 100 pounds, the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000).

19 "b. Is 100 pounds or more, but less than 500 pounds, 20 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of 21 imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of fifty 22 thousand dollars (\$50,000).

17 "b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than one kilo, 18 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of 19 imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of one 20 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

"c. Is one kilo, but less than 10 kilos, then the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of 15 calendar years and to pay a fine of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000).

"(3) Any person, except as otherwise authorized by 4 5 law, who knowingly sells, manufactures, delivers, or brings 6 into this state, or who is knowingly in actual or constructive 7 possession of, four grams or more of any morphine, opium, or any salt, isomer, or salt of an isomer thereof, including 8 9 heroin, as described in Section 20-2-23(b)(2) or Section 10 20-2-25(1)a., or four grams or more of any mixture containing 11 any such substance, or any mixture containing Fentanyl or any 12 synthetic controlled substance Fentanyl analogue, as described in Sections 20-2-23 and 20-2-25, is guilty of a felony, which 13 14 felony shall be known as "trafficking in illegal drugs." If 15 the quantity involved:

16 "a. Is four grams or more, but less than 14 grams, 17 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of 18 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of 19 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

"b. Is 14 grams or more, but less than 28 grams, the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of 10 calendar years and to pay a fine of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

"c. Is 28 grams or more, but less than 56 grams, the
person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of

1 imprisonment of 25 calendar years and to pay a fine of five 2 hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000).

3 "d. Is 56 grams or more, the person shall be

"c. Is 25,000 pills or more, but less than 100,000 pills or capsules, the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of 25 calendar years and pay a fine of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000).

4 "(5) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures,

9 "trafficking in illegal drugs." If the quantity involved:

"a. Is 500 pills or capsules or more but less than 1,000 pills or capsules, the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

14 "b. Is 1,000 pills or capsules or more, but less 15 than 4,000 pills or capsules, the person shall be sentenced to 16 a mandatory term of imprisonment of 10 calendar years and to 17 pay a fine of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

18 "c. Is 4,000 pills or capsules or more but less than 19 10,000 pills or capsules, the person shall be sentenced to a 20 mandatory term of imprisonment of 25 calendar years and to pay 21 a fine of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

"d. Is more than 10,000 pills or capsules, the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory term of life in prison without parole. "(6) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures, delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in actual or constructive possession of, 28 grams or more of 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or of any mixture containing 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, is guilty of a felony, which felony shall be known as "trafficking in illegal drugs." If the quantity involved:

8 "a. Is 28 grams or more, but less than 500 grams, 9 the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of 10 imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of 11 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

"a. Is 28 grams or more but less than 500 grams, the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

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1	"b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than one kilo,
2	the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
3	imprisonment of five calendar years and to pay a fine of one
4	hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).
5	"c. Is one kilo but less than 10 kilos, then the

8 sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment of life without
9 parole.

"(12) Any person who knowingly sells, manufactures, 10 11 delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in 12 actual or constructive possession of 56 or more grams of a 13 synthetic controlled substance or a synthetic controlled 14 substance analogue, as described in subdivision (4) or (5) of 15 subsection (a) of Section 20-2-23, except for any synthetic 16 controlled substance Fentanyl analogue referenced in 17 subdivisions (13), is guilty of a felony, which felony shall be known as "trafficking in synthetic controlled substances." 18 19 If the quantity involved:

"a. Is 56 grams or more, but less than 500 grams,
the person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
imprisonment of three calendar years and to pay a fine of
fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

24 "b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than 1 kilo, the 25 person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of

1 imprisonment of 10 calendar years and to pay a fine of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000). 2 3 "c. 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"§20-2-23.

"(a) The Legislature finds the following:

"(1) New synthetic substances are being created which are not controlled under the provisions of existing state law but which have a potential for abuse similar to or greater than that for substances controlled under existing state law. These new synthetic substances are called

"synthetic controlled substances or synthetic controlled substance analogues" and can be designed to produce a desired pharmacological effect and to evade the controlling statutory provisions. Synthetic controlled substances or synthetic controlled substance analogues are being manufactured, distributed, possessed, and used as substitutes for controlled substances.

8 "(2) The hazards attributable to the traffic in and 9 use of a synthetic controlled substance or synthetic 10 controlled substance analogues are increased because their 11 unregulated manufacture produces variations in purity and 12 concentration.

13 "(3) Many new synthetic substances are untested, and 14 it cannot be immediately determined whether they have useful 15 medical or chemical purposes.

16 "(4) The uncontrolled importation, manufacture, 17 distribution, possession, or use of controlled substance 18 analogues has a substantial and detrimental impact on the 19 health and safety of the people of this state.

"(5) Synthetic controlled substances or synthetic controlled substance analogues can be created more rapidly than they can be identified and controlled by action of the Legislature. There is a need for a speedy determination of their proper classification under existing law. It is therefore necessary to identify and classify new substances

1 that have a potential for abuse, so that they can be controlled in the same manner as other substances controlled 2 3 under existing state law. "(b) The controlled substances listed in this 4 section are included in Schedule I: 5 6 "(1) Any of the following opiates, including their 7 isomers, esters, ethers, salts, and salts of isomers, esters 8 and ethers, unless specifically excepted, whenever the 9 existence of these isomers, esters, ethers and salts is possible within the specific chemical designation: 10 11 "a. 3 Section 2. The amendatory language in this act shall
4 only apply to offenses occurring on or after the effective
5 date of this act and shall not apply retroactively.

6 Section 3. Although this bill would have as its 7 purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further 8 9 requirements and application under Amendment 621, now 10 appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of 11 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the 12 bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an 13 existing crime.

14 Section 4. This act shall become effective 15 immediately following its passage and approval by the 16 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
