Section 2. All sections of this act are hereby declared to be severable. If any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this act shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by the judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such constitutionality or invalidity shall not render the entire act null and void.

Section 3. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is proposed to be annexed to the municipality of Lincoln is on

file in the office of the Judge of Probate in Talladega

County, Alabama, and the map is open to the inspection of the public.

Section 4. This act shall become effective upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its otherwise

becoming law.
