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9 A BILL  
10 TO BE ENTITLED  
11 AN ACT  
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13 Relating to the Town of Pike Road in Montgomery  
14 County; to authorize the municipal governing body to levy and  
15 provide for the collection of additional ad valorem taxes on  
16 taxable property located in the Town, pursuant to Section 217  
17 of the Official ReCompilation of the Alabama Constitution of  
18 1901; to provide for a referendum; to provide for the proceeds  
19 from the additional taxes to be allocated for public schools  
20 in the town; and to provide for the administration, collection  
21 and allocation of all ad valorem taxes in the Town of Pike  
22 Road.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

24 Section 1. In addition to all other ad valorem taxes  
25 now existing or otherwise authorized by law in the Town of  
26 Pike Road, and in accordance with the pertinent provisions of  
27 subsection (f) of Section 217 of the Official ReCompilation of

1 the Constitution of Alabama 1901, as amended, the governing  
2 body of the Town of Pike Road, Alabama, in Montgomery County  
3 may levy and provide for the collection of up to an additional  
4 twenty-five (25) mills ad valorem taxes on taxable property  
5 situated in the town.

6 Section 2. The increase in the rate at which the ad  
7 valorem tax may be levied and collected pursuant to this act  
8 is subject to the approval of a majority of the qualified  
9 electors residing in the Town of Pike Road who vote on the  
10 proposed increase at a special election called and held for  
11 such purpose as provided for in Section 217 of the Official  
12 Recompilation of the Alabama Constitution of 1901, as amended.

13 Section 3. The additional revenue from the  
14 additional ad valorem tax increase shall be paid to the  
15 municipal general fund and be allocated and expended for  
16 public school purposes within the Town of Pike Road.

17 Section 4. All ad valorem taxes in the Town of Pike  
18 Road shall be levied, collected, administered and enforced at  
19 the same time, in the same manner, and under the same  
20 requirements and laws as state ad valorem taxes. The officials  
21 collecting or assessing such taxes shall be entitled to the  
22 same fee and compensation as are provided for collecting and  
23 assessing ad valorem taxes, generally, in Montgomery County,  
24 Alabama.

25 Section 5. This act shall become effective  
26 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or  
27 its otherwise becoming law.
