1 Section 1. In addition to any other applicable 2 penalty, fine, or sanction against a provider of pharmaceuticals to the Alabama Medicaid Agency based on a 3 fraudulent act of deliberately overcharging the agency for pharmaceutical products, the provider shall be liable for a 5 per transaction forfeiture of not less than one hundred 6 7 dollars (\$100) nor more than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for each such transaction with the agency. 8 Section 2. All forfeiture amounts for which a 9 10 provider is liable pursuant to Section 1 shall be paid to the 11 State General Fund. 12 Section 3. This act shall become effective 13 immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law. 14
