1 SB44 2 3 4 ENROLLED, An Act, 5 To amend Sections 34-21-60, 34-21-61, 34-21-62, and 6 34-21-63, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to graduate degree 7 scholarships for nurses; to increase the amount of such 8 scholarships; to require applicants to meet additional 9 qualifications; and to require any appropriation to fund the 10 scholarships be made through the Education Trust Fund. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 11 12 Section 1. Sections 34-21-60, 34-21-61, 34-21-62, and 34-21-63 of the Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read 13 14 as follows: 15 "§34-21-60. "There shall be established for the fiscal year 16 17 ending September 30, 2012, scholarships for graduate education 18 of nurses. These scholarships shall be awarded to applicants 19 from the State of Alabama at large. They shall be distributed, 20 insofar as practicable, throughout the state. The number of 21 scholarships shall equal five percent of the total enrollment 22 in graduate nursing programs in Alabama. Each scholarship is 23 limited to ten thousand dollars (\$10,000). 24 "§34-21-61.

"(a) To be eligible to receive a scholarship 1 2 provided by this article, an applicant shall satisfy all of 3 the following requirements: "(1) Be a resident of the State of Alabama for a 4 5 period of at least one year immediately preceding the time of 6 making application. "(2) Be a person of good character. 7 "(3) Have an active, unencumbered license as a 8 9 professional nurse in Alabama. 10 "(4) Be accepted for an Alabama graduate program 11 conducted by an accredited college or university. 12 "(5) Agree to practice professional nursing or 13 become a nursing instructor in the State of Alabama for at 14 least two years after completing the graduate degree. The 15 recipient of these scholarships may apply to the Board of Nursing for a waiver from these requirements for extenuating 16 17 circumstances beyond the control of the recipient. 18 "(b) Preference shall be given to applicants 19 pursuing a career in nursing education. 20 "(c) These scholarships shall be available to 21 applicants seeking master's or doctorate degrees in nursing. 22 Doctorate degrees in education are also acceptable provided 23 the applicant holds a graduate degree in nursing. 24 "(d) Application for these scholarships shall be 25 made to the Alabama Board of Nursing. The Board of Nursing

shall receive five percent of the total appropriation to
administer the scholarships.

"§34-21-62.

"Each scholarship provided for by this article shall 4 5 not exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per year, payable from funds appropriated to the Alabama Board of Nursing for 6 7 this purpose. Contingent upon subsequent legislative funding of this program, a scholarship may either be renewed by the 8 Alabama Board of Nursing for the same student or awarded to 9 10 another applicant for the scholarship. Criteria for the 11 selection of recipients and awarding of the scholarships shall 12 be established by the Alabama Board of Nursing. These criteria 13 shall be used as guides in the selection of the scholarship 14 recipients from the various geographical areas of the state. In case a scholarship student fails to complete the course 15 16 prescribed for a graduate degree in nursing, that student 17 shall repay the amount of any scholarship funds received 18 hereunder to the State Treasury. In the event of the 19 scholarship recipient's death, the obligation for funds 20 disbursed and not repaid shall be cancelled. In the event the 21 scholarship recipient becomes mentally or physically impaired 22 and is unable to complete a graduate course in nursing, or has received a graduate degree but is unable to complete one year 23 24 of service as a nurse due to such disability, the obligation 25 for funds disbursed and not repaid shall be cancelled.
