13 Relating to Cherokee and DeKalb Counties; to provide
14 that any person employed as an investigator by the Ninth
15 Judicial Circuit who serves for 10 years or more and leaves
16 the office in good standing shall receive, at the district
17 attorney's discretion, his or her service pistol and badge; to
18 provide that investigators for the District Attorney of the
19 Ninth Judicial Circuit shall be hired pursuant to general law;
20 and to repeal Section 45-10-80, Code of Alabama 1975, relating
21 to arrest and service of search warrants by investigators for
22 the District Attorney of the Ninth Judicial Circuit.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

24 Section 1. (a) Any person employed as an
25 investigator for the District Attorney of the Ninth Judicial
26 Circuit, composed of Cherokee and DeKalb Counties, for a
27 period of 10 years or more who leaves office in good standing,

1 by retirement or otherwise, shall receive from the office, at
2 the discretion of the district attorney, without cost to him
3 or her, his or her service pistol and badge.

4 (b) Investigators for the District Attorney in the
5 Ninth Judicial Circuit shall be employed under the general law
6 pursuant to Section 12-17-220.1 of the Code of Alabama 1975.

7 Section 2. Section 45-10-80, Code of Alabama 1975,
8 relating to arrest and service of search warrants by
9 investigators for the District Attorney of the Ninth Judicial
10 Circuit, is repealed.

11 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
12 first day of the third month following its passage and
13 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
