8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would provide for the issuance of
9 a distinctive motorcycle license plate for ovarian
10 cancer research.

11 This bill would provide for an annual
12 additional fee of fifty dollars to be collected for
13 each distinctive motorcycle license plate issued,
14 for the distribution of the net proceeds for
15 ovarian cancer research, and for the design of the
16 distinctive motorcycle license plate.

22 Relating to motor vehicles, to provide for the
23 issuance of a distinctive motorcycle license plate for ovarian
24 cancer research under certain conditions; to provide for an
25 additional annual fee; to provide for the distribution of the
26 net proceeds; and to provide for the design.

27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1 Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of
2 Section 32-6-64, Code of Alabama 1975, upon application to the
3 judge of probate or license commissioner, compliance with
4 motor vehicle registration and licensing laws, payment of
5 regular fees required by law for license plates for private
6 passenger or pleasure motorcycles, and payment of an
7 additional annual fee of fifty dollars (\$50), owners of
8 motorcycles who are residents of Alabama shall be issued
9 distinctive "Ovarian Cancer Research" license plates.

10 (b) These plates shall be valid for five years, and
11 may then be replaced with either conventional, personalized,
12 or new "Ovarian Cancer Research" plates.

13 (c) Payment of required license fees and taxes for
14 the years during which a new plate is not issued shall be
15 evidenced as provided in Section 32-6-63, Code of Alabama
16 1975.

17 (d) The Norma Livingston Ovarian Cancer Foundation
18 shall design, or have designed, the plate, which design shall
19 be approved by the Commissioner of Revenue. Section 32-6-54,
20 Code of Alabama 1975, shall not apply to the plates designed
21 pursuant to this section.

22 (e) The plates shall be issued, printed, and
23 processed like other distinctive and personalized plates
24 provided for in Chapter 6 of Title 32.

25 (f) The annual additional fee for the motorcycle
26 plates shall be distributed in accordance with Section 32-6-68
27 of the Code of Alabama 1975. The Norma Livingston Ovarian

1 Cancer Foundation shall receive the portion of the fee as the
2 sponsoring organization, which funds shall be used to provide
3 funding for ovarian cancer research in the State of Alabama.

4 (g) The Department of Revenue may promulgate rules
5 to implement this act.

6 Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
7 with this act are repealed.

8 Section 3. This act shall become effective on
9 January 1, 2015, following its passage and approval by the
10 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
