8 SYNOPSIS: Currently 1% of the 1-mill ad valorem tax
9 was originally designated for old age pension for
10 the relief of needy Confederate soldiers.

11 This bill earmarks one-third of one percent
12 of the 1-mill ad valorem tax for operating and
13 capital expenditures of the First White House of
14 the Confederacy and provides for an appropriation.

17 TO BE ENTITLED

20 Relating to the 1-mill ad valorem tax: designating
21 one-third of one percent annually to the First White House of
22 the Confederacy for operational costs, capital expenditures
23 and maintenance and providing for an appropriation.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

25 Section 1. Section 40-8-3, Code of Alabama, 1975 is
26 hereby amended to read as follows:

1 "§40-8-3.

2 "There is hereby levied for the purpose and upon the
3 property hereinafter named and not specifically exempted from
4 taxation annual taxes, as follows:

5 (1) For the maintenance of the public schools of
6 this state, \$.30 on each \$100 of the assessed value of taxable
7 property.

8 (2) For the relief of needy Confederate soldiers and
9 sailors, resident citizens of Alabama and their widows, \$.10
10 on each \$100 of the assessed value of taxable property of
11 which one percent of the gross amount collected will be
12 expended by the Alabama Historical Commission to provide for
13 capital improvements and maintenance at the Confederate
14 Memorial Park at Mountain Creek, Chilton County, Alabama, and
15 of which one-third of one percent of the gross amount
16 collected will be expended by the First White House of the
17 Confederacy to provide for operational costs, capital
18 improvements and maintenance.

19 (3) For the use of the state and to raise revenue
20 therefor, \$.25 on each \$100 of the assessed value of taxable
21 property."

22 Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations
23 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated to
24 the First White House of the Confederacy the amount generated
25 by the one-third of one percent of the 1-mill ad valorem tax
26 allocated herein for the First White House of the Confederacy

1 for the fiscal years ending September 30, 2012 and September
2 30, 2013.

3 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
4 first day of the third month following its passage and
5 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming a law.
