14 TO BE ENTITLED

15 AN ACT

Relating to public health; to exempt U.S. Department of Defense events held in the state from any state public health law if the law conflicts with a regulation, law, or condition required by the Department of Defense to attend the event.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Any state law relating to public health shall not apply to any conference, convention, meeting, symposium, exposition, or other event held in the state which is sponsored by, or for the benefit of, the U.S. Department of Defense, if the state law conflicts with a law, regulation, or condition required by the Department of Defense as a condition of attending the event.
