4	SYNOPSIS:
5	Under existing law, a local board of education
6	may contract with a local chief of police or sheriff to
7	employ school resource officers.
8	This bill would authorize a sheriff or local
9	chief of police to contract with a nonpublic K-12
10	school for the provision of school resource officers.
11	This bill would also require a sheriff or local
12	chief of police to charge the nonpublic school for the
13	full cost of employing any school resource officer.

20	Relating to school safety; to authorize a sheriff or
21	local chief of police to contract with a nonpublic K-12 school
22	to provide school resource officers; and to require a sheriff
23	or local police chief to charge the nonpublic school for the
24	full cost of employing any school resource officer.
25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. (a) A sheriff or local chief of police may
27	contract with a nonpublic school, including private, church,
28	parochial, and religious schools, offering educational

instruction in grades K-12, as well as home-schooling 29 30 entities, to provide school resource officers, as defined in Section 16-1-44.1, Code of Alabama 1975. 31 32 (b) A sheriff or local chief of police providing a 33 school resource officer pursuant to subsection (a) shall 34 charge the nonpublic school the full salary, benefits, and any other costs associated with the continued employment of each 35 36 school resource officer. Section 2. This act shall become effective June 1, 37 2024, following its passage and approval by the Governor, or 38 39 its otherwise becoming law.
