21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
22	Section 1. The following amendment to the
23	Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become
24	valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of
25	this act are fulfilled:
26	PROPOSED AMENDMENT

1 (a) In Madison County, a qualified taxpayer may
2 claim a senior discount on his or her ad valorem taxes. A
3 qualified taxpayer shall meet all the following requirements
4 to be eligible for the senior discount:

- (1) Be age 65 or older for the tax year for which he or she claims the discount.
- (2) Shall have maintained the property on which the senior discount is claimed as his or her principal place of residence for at least 10 years prior to claiming the senior discount.
- (b) The senior discount provided for herein shall be the difference between the ad valorem taxes otherwise due and the ad valorem tax imposed on October 1 of the year prior to the year the senior discount is claimed. The senior discount shall be claimed in the manner that a homestead exemption is claimed.
- (c) The Alabama Department of Revenue shall promulgate such rules as are necessary for the implementation and administration of the provisions of this amendment.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional

4	"Relating to Madison County, proposing an amendment
