12 WHEREAS, First Sergeant Mitchell is a true American
13 hero whose noble character and qualities saved lives; and

14 WHEREAS, First Sergeant Mitchell's unwavering 15 commitment to excellence in the defense of freedom and 16 democracy reflects honor upon the entire United States of 17 America, and he is truly deserving of special recognition; now 18 therefore,
