5 ADJUSTING THE EXISTING WALTER C. GIVHAN PARKWAY.

7 WHEREAS, Walter C. Givhan was born in Perry County,
8 Alabama on May 7, 1902, before his family moved a few miles
9 east into Dallas County, near the community of Safford,
10 Alabama, where he grew up on his family's farm; and

11 WHEREAS, he graduated from the University of Georgia
12 System, North Georgia Agricultural College at Dahlonega, in
13 1921, with a degree in Agriculture and then returned to Dallas
14 County to begin a career as a farmer and a rancher; and

15 WHEREAS, he was first elected to the Alabama House
16 of Representatives in 1930, serving until 1934, and reelected
17 in 1942, serving until 1954, and was later elected to the
18 Alabama Senate in 1954, serving until his death on February
19 18, 1976, serving a total of 38 years in the Alabama
20 Legislature; and

21 WHEREAS, Senator Givhan was a champion of farmers,
22 and was posthumously recognized by Auburn University as the
23 "father of the soybean movement in Alabama"; and

24 WHEREAS, Senator Givhan's saying of "Never forsake
25 an old friend for a new friend and make all the friends you

1 can" is still repeated in the Alabama State House; now
2 therefore,

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
4 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we declare that the portion of
5 Alabama Highway 8 (U.S. Highway 80) currently identified as
6 the WALTER C. GIVHAN PARKWAY be relocated to begin at the East
7 Dallas County Line through Dallas County and Perry County to
8 the Perry County Boundary with Marengo County, with the
9 portion of said highway located in Dallas and Perry Counties
10 be designated and named as the WALTER C. GIVHAN PARKWAY.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the appropriate
12 officials be requested to remove conflicting signs or markers
13 in Montgomery County and Lowndes County; to maintain existing
14 signs or markers in Dallas County; to place and maintain signs
15 or markers at the east and west boundaries of each respective
16 county line; and to place signs and markers at the other
17 suitable locations, visible for eastbound and westbound
18 traffic, including a site west of the Selma police
19 jurisdiction.
