11	Preparedness Commission is created to study the state's

14	(2) The commission is charged with reviewing the
15	response of the legislative, executive, and judicial branches
16	of state government, as well as the response of county and
17	municipal governments, to the pandemic.
18	(3) For each branch or level of government, the
19	commission shall identify the principal actions taken in
20	response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the costs and benefits of
21	those actions, and how those actions compared to actions taken
22	in other states.
23	(4) The commission or any of its members may make
24	recommendations on future legislation, policies, or practices

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1	that will assist the state in more effectively responding to a
2	future pandemic.
3	(b)(1) The commission shall be comprised of the
4	following members:
5	a. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate or his or
6	her designee.
7	b. A member of the Senate appointed by the President
8	Pro Tempore of the Senate.
9	c. The Minority Leader of the Senate or his or her
10	designee.
11	d. The Speaker of the House of Representatives or
12	his or her designee.
13	e. A member of the House of Representatives
14	appointed by the Speaker.
15	f. The Minority Leaders of the House of
16	Representatives or his or her designee.
17	g. The Governor or his or her designee.
18	h. The State Health Officer or his or her designee.
19	i. The State Finance Director or his or her
20	designee.
21	j. The Secretary of the Alabama Department of Labor.
22	k. The Director of the Alabama Emergency Management

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Agency.

	(2)	The con	mission,	by a	majority	vote,	may inclu	de

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- (3) All appointing authorities shall coordinate their appointments so that diversity of gender, race, and geographical areas is reflective of the makeup of this state.
- (c) (1) The commission shall hold its first meeting at the call of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate within 90 calendar days of the passage of this resolution. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives, or their designees, shall serve as co-chairs of the commission.
- (2) The commission shall thereafter meet at the call of the chair, provided that the commission shall meet at least three times. At least one meeting of the commission shall be a public hearing to receive comments from members of the public concerning the costs and benefits of COVID-19 response measures in this state.
- (d) (1) Non-legislative members shall serve without compensation except for travel reimbursement to be paid by the member's department or agency according to state law.
- (2) Legislative members of the commission shall be entitled to their regular legislative compensation, per diem, and travel expenses each day they attend a meeting of the commission in accordance with Amendment 871 to the

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1	Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section
2	49.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
3	Alabama of 1901, as amended. These payments shall be paid out
4	of any funds appropriated for the use of the Legislature by
5	means of warrants drawn by the Comptroller on the State
6	Treasury.

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(e) The commission shall submit a report of its findings and any recommendations to the Governor and the Legislature on or before the first day of the 2022 Regular Session, at which time it shall stand dissolved.
