5 URGING LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEMS AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL
6 ENTITIES WHOSE BUILDINGS WERE DAMAGED OR DESTROYED BY THE
7 RECENT TORNADOES TO HIRE OR USE LOCAL AND IN-STATE CONTRACTORS
8 TO REBUILD OR REPAIR THOSE BUILDINGS.

10 WHEREAS, the economy of the areas of this State was
11 adversely affected by the recent tornadoes; and

12 WHEREAS, buildings and other structures owned by
13 local school systems and local governmental entities were
14 damaged or destroyed by the tornadoes; and

15 WHEREAS, Alabamians pay taxes to make it possible to
16 repair the buildings and other structures owned by local
17 systems and local governmental entities that were damaged or
18 destroyed by the tornadoes; and

19 WHEREAS, it would be positive for the morale of the
20 residents adversely affected by the tornadoes as well as the
21 local economy if, to the extent possible, local school systems
22 and local governmental entities hire or use local and in-state
23 contractors to rebuild or repair buildings damaged or
24 destroyed by the tornadoes; and

1 WHEREAS, Alabama has local and in-state contractors
2 who are well-trained and who have the ability to rebuild or
3 repair buildings damaged or destroyed by the tornadoes; now
4 therefore,

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
6 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That this Legislature strongly
7 urges, and indeed expects to the extent possible that local
8 school systems and local governmental entities hire or use
9 local and in-state contractors to rebuild or repair buildings
10 that were damaged or destroyed by the tornadoes.
