8 greatest joys in Mrs. Gordon's life; she is remembered for her
9 tireless work ethic, amazing, sweet-hearted nature, and a life
10 lived in service to others; many considered her a best friend,
11 and she was everything to everybody; she was a faithful and
12 dedicated member of West Hobbs Street Church of Christ; and

13 WHEREAS, survivors include her dear husband;
14 daughter, Lori Ann Ermert (Mike); son, David W. Gordon
15 (Kelli); grandchildren, Amanda Gordon Abernathy (Phillip);

17 and siblings, Franklin Thornton (Telula), Ruby Smith (Buddy),
