8 WHEREAS, Alabama's international exports continue to 9 be one of the state's most powerful economic engines, 10 setting a new record of \$27.4 billion in 2023; and

11 WHEREAS, despite the challenges of uncertain global 12 trade issues, Alabama has maintained and strengthened its 13 reputation as a reliable, world class exporter of the finest 14 goods and services, underscoring the resilience of Alabama's 15 economy; and

16 WHEREAS, to meet international consumer demands, 17 Alabama exports of goods and services from Alabama were 18 shipped to 190 countries; and

19 WHEREAS, Alabama exports a variety of products 20 worldwide, such as, vehicles, transportation equipment, 21 agricultural products, chemicals, minerals, iron, steel, 22 machinery, and paper products; and

23 WHEREAS, Alabama's number one export category is
24 transportation equipment at \$14.8 billion; and

25 WHEREAS, other aerospace products and parts have 26 increased in sales to \$2.1 billion, a rise of 23 percent 27 from 2022; and

28 WHEREAS, there is a worldwide demand for quality

29 goods and services; Alabama exports are much sought after by 30 international consumers; and Alabama-based products are 31 second to none in quality; and

32 WHEREAS, Alabama's business community, long known for 33 its resilience and ability to innovate during recent 34 unprecedented times, will promise long-term growth in 2024; 35 and

36 WHEREAS, we recognize the dedication and 37 professionalism of Alabama's trade and export professionals, 38 including, the Alabama Department of Commerce, the Alabama Department of Agriculture and Industries, the Port of 39 40 Mobile, Export Alabama Alliance, trade organizations, and 41 trade research groups; Alabama's manufacturing and 42 transportation sectors, agriculture, and small businesses 43 that export their products worldwide; and the hard working 44 men and women who are the backbone of Alabama's export and 45 trade sector; now therefore,

46 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH 47 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That international trade contributes significantly to the state's economy and 48 49 sustains thousands of high paying jobs; we congratulate all 50 of those who have contributed to Alabama's record 2023 export performance, and we encourage the continued growth of 51 52 Alabama's "Made in Alabama" brand of exports to the global 53 marketplace.
