The number of 7 a state's congressional districts is based upon each state's 8 proportion of the national population, counted every 10 years; 9 now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we urge the Reapportionment Office to work with the U.S. Census Bureau in developing a statewide outreach plan to assist the Legislature in increasing awareness about the census and motivate residents in the targeted communities to respond for an accurate population count for Alabama.
