9 WHEREAS, we join the students, coaches, parents, and 10 faculty at Jasper High School in celebrating the Girls 11 Basketball Team's Alabama High School Athletic Association 12 (AHSAA) Class 5A State Basketball Championship; and

WHEREAS, on March 2, 2024, at the BJCC Legacy Arena in Birmingham, the Jasper High School Girls Basketball Team defied expectations by securing their first State Title in the program's history with a 48-44 victory over Scottsboro High School; and

18 WHEREAS, senior Mia Hollingsworth earned tournament 19 MVP honors and was instrumental in the team's victory after 20 finishing with 16 points, five rebounds, two assists, and 21 two steals; she scored the go-ahead basket on a layup, 22 drawing a foul on the play, and converted the and-1 23 opportunity to push the lead with 4:01 remaining in the 24 game; and

25 WHEREAS, other notable standouts were sophomore Missy 26 Odom who tied Mia Hollingsworth for a team-high with 16 27 points, adding seven rebounds, two steals, and two blocked 28 shots; senior Hallie Harrell added 12 points and seven

29 rebounds; senior Idaysia Mercer produced only 2 points, but 30 dished out 4 assists with only 1 turnover; and

31 WHEREAS, student athletes Mia Hollingsworth, Missy 32 Odom, and Idaysia Mercer were honored with selection for the 33 Class 5A Girls All-Tourney Team; and

34 WHEREAS, the Jasper High School Girls Basketball 35 Program has been superbly coached and inspired by Head 36 Varsity Coach Blake Laney and Assistant Coaches Vess 37 Hollingsworth and Jackee Key; under their leadership the 38 players have broadened their knowledge of the game, refined 39 their skills in execution, and furthered the tradition of 40 superior play and true sportsmanship; and

41 WHEREAS, the 2023-2024 Jasper High School Girls 42 Basketball team ended the season with an overall record of 43 31-4, which is the second-most wins in school history; they distinctively broke the AHSAA State record by completing 22 44 45 three-shots made in a single game; went 6-0 in 5A Area 10 46 play; are the Regular Season 5A Area 10 Champions and the Northwest Regional Champions; their successes reflect their 47 resiliency and ability to exceed expectations; they have 48 49 proven that determination and strategic gameplay can lead to 50 excellence; and

51 WHEREAS, the 2023-2024 Jasper High School Girls 52 Championship roster includes seniors, Idaysia Mercer, 53 Jakayla Kirk, Hallie Harrell, Ally Grace Salors, and Mia 54 Hollingsworth; Sophomores, Marianna Rigsby, DeCaleigh 55 Calvin, and Missy Odom; Freshmen, Gracen Norris and Emma Lou 56 Franks; and 8th Grader, Sara Katherine Bonner; now
