26 half of the workforce of the United States and make up 99.7 27 percent of all employees in the United States; and 28 WHEREAS, small businesses produce one-third of the 29 exports of the United States and account for nearly half of private sector output, and Alabama small firms exported 30 31 goods worth over \$2 billion; and 32 WHEREAS, 9.1 percent of all small business owners 33 are veterans; and WHEREAS, women make up 47 percent of small business 34 workers and own 43 percent of small businesses; and 35 36 WHEREAS, two out of every three new jobs in the United States are created by small businesses; now 37 38 therefore, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH 39 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we support the week of April 40 41 30 - May 6, 2023, as National Small Business Week; we 42 encourage all residents of Alabama to: (1) celebrate the entrepreneurial spirit of small business owners in Alabama 43 44 and our nation who have chartered their own course to 45 provide jobs and bright futures for millions of American 46 workers; (2) understand the importance of creating a small 47 business climate that allows for sustained economic recovery; (3) celebrate the invaluable contribution that 48 small businesses make to the United States and to Alabama as 49 50 the backbone of the economy; (4) support increasing consumer
