5 MOURNING THE DEATH OF DR. HENRY THOMAS SCOTT, JR.

7 WHEREAS, with profound sorrow and regret, we receive
8 news of the death of Dr. Henry Thomas Scott, Jr., of
9 Inverness, Alabama, on August 2, 2010; and

10 WHEREAS, a native of Houston, Texas, he moved to
11 Birmingham at an early age and graduated from Woodlawn High
12 School prior to enlisting in the United States Navy, where he
13 was assigned to communication and armament in Manila Bay and
14 served with honor and distinction; and

15 WHEREAS, he earned his undergraduate degree from
16 Samford University and his professional degree from Palmer
17 College of Chiropractic in Davenport, Iowa, in 1951; and

18 WHEREAS, Dr. Scott was instrumental in getting the
19 state's Chiropractic Law passed on January 1, 1959, and held
20 Alabama License #6 from the Alabama State Board of
21 Chiropractic Examiners; and

22 WHEREAS, among his roles of professional leadership,
23 he served as president of the Alabama State Board of
24 Chiropractic Examiners three times, president of the Alabama
25 State Chiropractic Association for two terms, and was an

1 active member of the American Chiropractic Association, Palmer
2 CIAA, and the Federation of Chiropractic Examiners Board; and

3 WHEREAS, he was named Chiropractor of the Year 1962
4 and honored as 2003 Lifetime Achiever in the Alabama

5 Chiropractic Hall of Fame; through the years, Dr. Scott was a
6 mentor and source of wisdom for many young chiropractors; and

7 WHEREAS, devoted to family and faith, he was an
8 18-year member of Vestavia Hills Church of Christ; and

9 WHEREAS, he is survived by his loving wife of 54
10 years, Evelyn Harris Scott; daughter, Linda Waldrop; two sons,
11 John Scott and Tommy Scott; seven grandchildren; and a
12 brother, Ralph Scott; and

13 WHEREAS, preceding him in death were his beloved
14 parents, Henry and Louise Scott, and brother, James Scott; and

15 WHEREAS, Dr. Scott was a devout Christian and an
16 enthusiastic positive motivator who promoted the good inside
17 each individual he encountered; his strength, endurance, and
18 quest for life were examples he taught to many and relayed to
19 his cherished family; now therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
21 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the death of Dr. Henry Thomas
22 Scott, Jr., is recorded with deep sadness, and this resolution
23 is offered in highest tribute to his life, along with
24 heartfelt sympathy to his grieving family.
