BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH 1 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we hereby request that when 2 3 Alabama adopts codes for commercial and residential structures as named by proposed legislation for a statewide building 4 5 code, that an energy code based on the 2006 International Energy Conservation Code (IECC) for residential buildings and 6 the ANSI/ASHRAE/IESNA Standard 90.1-2007 for commercial 7 8 buildings, or subsequent editions, changes, or recompilations 9 thereof, be included as a component of the building code or 10 codes that Alabama adopts, and that future consideration be 11 given to create an internal statewide process to amend the 12 code and increase the stringency, triennially, as new editions 13 of the IECC are published.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this 15 resolution be transmitted to each member of the Alabama 16 Building Commission.
