8 WHEREAS, Travis Grant was born in Clayton, Alabama;  
9 and

10 WHEREAS, he attended and graduated from Barbour  
11 County Training School where he excelled in basketball; and

12 WHEREAS, he is most known for being the all-time  
13 leading scorer in men's college basketball history while at  
14 Kentucky State University by amassing 4,045 points; and

15 WHEREAS, he was first round pick of the Los Angeles  
16 Lakers in the 1972 NBA Draft and of the Utah Stars in the 1972  
17 ABA Draft; and

18 WHEREAS, he played professionally in the National  
19 Basketball Association and American Basketball Association  
20 from 1972 to 1976, for the Los Angeles Lakers, San Diego  
21 Conquistadors, and Indiana Pacers; and

22 WHEREAS, his best season came in 1974-75 for the San  
23 Diego Conquistadors when he averaged 25.2 points per game and  
24 6.2 rebounds per game with a 54.4 percent field goal  
25 percentage; and

1           WHEREAS, after retirement from basketball he entered  
2 teaching and coaching as an assistant principal and athletic  
3 director at Stephenson High School in Atlanta, after 20 years  
4 at Walker High School, now McNair High School; now therefore,

5           BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
6 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we urge that Travis Grant be  
7 inducted into the Alabama Sports Hall Of Fame.
