> RECOGNIZING JANUARY 31 AS THE ANNUAL DATE FOR INTERNATIONAL OMPHALOCELE AWARENESS DAY IN ALABAMA AND COMMENDING THE SUPPORT GROUP MOTHERS OF OMPHALOCELES FOR ITS ADVOCACY EFFORTS.

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WHEREAS, we have a major responsibility to advocate much needed awareness surrounding the birth defect omphalocele to ensure the greatest quality of life for the children affected by the condition; and

WHEREAS, the birth defect omphalocele occurs early in pregnancy when the abdominal wall does not close properly and when some or most of the abdominal organs protrude on the outside of the baby's body through the umbilical cord; it is estimated that a small omphalocele occurs in about one out of every 5,000 pregnancies and that a giant omphalocele occurs in about one out of every 10,000 pregnancies; and

WHEREAS, an omphalocele may be isolated or associated with other defects or chromosomal abnormalities; despite the challenges babies born with omphaloceles might face, they typically survive to lead healthy, fulfilling lives; and

WHEREAS, by increasing awareness around
omphaloceles, families will receive pertinent information that
assures them the condition is not a death sentence; imperative
facts about omphaloceles also need to be brought to the
attention of doctors and medical staff so that termination is
not offered as a solution; and

WHEREAS, Mothers of Omphaloceles (MOO) is a support group that consists of almost 2,000 parents, family members, and survivors worldwide created in an effort to provide hope, support, and information to families with babies diagnosed with omphaloceles and any related abnormalities; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES CONCURRING, That we hereby recognize Mothers of Omphaloceles for courageous efforts on behalf of babies diagnosed with omphaloceles and for informing the public and medical personnel that it is a treatable condition, and we also recognize January 31 as the annual date of International Omphalocele Awareness Day in Alabama.
