BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we hereby urge the United States Congress to vote to propose the Regulation Freedom amendment to the United States Constitution as follows:

5 "Whenever one quarter of the members of the United 6 States House of Representatives or the United States Senate 7 transmits to the President their written declaration of 8 opposition to a proposed federal regulation, a majority vote 9 of both the House of Representatives and the Senate shall be 10 required to adopt that regulation."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution shall be provided to each member of Congress and to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate of each state legislature in the United States.

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
