5 MOURNING THE DEATH OF UNITED STATES NAVY COMMANDER  
6 LEE ALLEN HALLMAN.

8 WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the  
9 death on October 3, 2021, of Commander Lee Allen Hallman of  
10 Tuscaloosa, Alabama, at the age of 95 years; and

11 WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of  
12 his loving family, many friends, and the entire community,  
13 where he was highly regarded; and

14 WHEREAS, Commander Hallman was a graduate of  
15 Brookwood High School; following graduation he joined the  
16 United States Navy as a Seaman; he served during World War II,  
17 The Korean War, and The Vietnam War ; he retired after more  
18 than 30 years with the rank of Commander; and

19 WHEREAS, he earned a Master's Degree in Consumer  
20 Sciences from The University of Alabama at the age of 82  
21 years; and

22 WHEREAS, after retiring from the United States Navy,  
23 he worked as the Tuscaloosa County License Commissioner for 23  
24 years; and

1           WHEREAS, Commander Hallman was one of the founders  
2 of the Tuscaloosa Veterans Park; he was a founding member of  
3 the American Legion Post 34; he was exceptionally proud when  
4 the 1967 Post 34 baseball team won the American Legion  
5 National Championship; and

6           WHEREAS, survivors include his beloved wife of 37  
7 years, Mrs. Mary Nell Hallman; daughters, LaVondra Hallman  
8 Dobbs and LeAn Hallman Shockney (Doug); son, Lee Allen  
9 Hallman, II (Susan); sister, Faye Price (Danny);  
10 brother-in-law, Charles Caddell (Linda); grandchildren,  
11 Lindsey Nicole Hallman Casey (Josh), Tyler Ellis Dobbs, Tanner  
12 Lee Hallman, Carson Hallman Shockney, and Jeremy Allen Dobbs;  
13 great-grandchildren, Kennedy Scout Casey and Colin Grey Casey;  
14 and a host of other relatives and friends.

16 missed, the memory of Commander Hallman will be cherished in  
17 the hearts of all who knew and loved him; and
