25 as an NFL scout, and right before his college graduation, he

1 received a call from the Jacksonville Jaguars to serve as an
2 NFL scout for them; in 1995, he joined the Jacksonville
3 Jaguars as a scout under then Head Coach Tom Coughlin; during
4 Mr. Snead's time in Jacksonville, Florida, he learned how to
5 use Microsoft Excel from one of the IT workers, which he
6 credits to helping propel his career; in 1997, he served as a
7 scout for the Falcons, and from 2009 to 2011, he served as the
8 Falcons' Director of Player Personnel; in 2012, he became the
9 General Manager of the Los Angeles Rams and has held the
10 position ever since; on Sunday, February 13, 2022, Mr. Snead
11 and the Los Angeles Rams victoriously claimed the team's first
12 Super Bowl win since 1999; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Snead continues to prove that with
14 dedication and hard work, dreams do come true; he is indeed an
15 incredible inspiration in the lives of many; now therefore,
