8 WHEREAS, a life-long resident of Birmingham,  
9 Alabama, Senator Jabo Waggoner is currently serving his sixth  
10 term in the Alabama Senate after serving in the Alabama House  
11 of Representatives from 1966 through 1983; thus, he holds the  
12 longest record of legislative service of anyone from Jefferson  
13 County; and

14 WHEREAS, Senator Waggoner is President of Birmingham  
15 Business Consultants, LLC; he is a graduate of  
16 Birmingham-Southern College and Birmingham School of Law; he  
17 and his wife Marilyn are the parents of four children: Scott  
18 (deceased), Mark, Jay, and Lyn Waggoner Kilpatrick; and

19 WHEREAS, Senator Waggoner is a member of the  
20 Homewood Church of Christ, and has served as head coach of the  
21 Birmingham Touchdown Club and as president of the Birmingham  
22 Tip-Off Club; he was inducted into the Birmingham-Southern  
23 College Sports Hall of Fame in 2007; he serves on the  
24 following boards: Executive Committee of Birmingham Business  
25 Alliance; Faulkner University Board of Trustees; Birmingham,

1 Hoover, Shelby County, and Vestavia Hills Chambers of  
2 Commerce; Vestavia Hills Civitan Club; Greater Birmingham  
3 Convention and Visitors Bureau; Alabama Sports Hall of Fame;  
4 and Pinnacle Bank; and

5 WHEREAS, Senator Waggoner is a Republican and served  
6 as Senate Minority Leader from 2002 through 2010; he was  
7 elected Senate Majority Leader on December 8, 2010; he has  
8 served on numerous Senate committees including Banking and  
9 Insurance, County and Municipal Government, Finance and  
10 Taxation Education, Finance and Taxation General Fund, Health  
11 and Human Services, and Local Legislation Shelby County; he  
12 has served as Chair of the Local Legislation Committee for  
13 Jefferson County and the Rules Committee; and he has served as  
14 Vice Chair of the Confirmations Committee; and

15 WHEREAS, in addition to receiving the Ronald Reagan  
16 Lifetime Achievement Award in 2012, Senator Waggoner has  
17 received the following awards: 2012 Greater Birmingham  
18 Association of Home Builders Housing Hall of Fame; 2013  
19 Alabama State Council on the Arts Special Council Award; 2013  
20 Birmingham-Southern College Alumni of the Year and  
21 Distinguished Alumni Award; 2013 Subcontractors Association of  
22 Alabama Outstanding Legislator of the Year; and

23 WHEREAS, it is appropriate and desirable to honor  
24 Senator Jabo Waggoner for his tireless and dedicated service  
25 to the citizens of Alabama; now therefore,

1                   BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
2           HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in honor of Senator Jabo  
3           Waggoner, we declare that portion of Interstate 65 from mile  
4           marker 248 to Exit 252, be named the "Senator Jabo Waggoner  
5           Freeway."
