8 CELEBRATING THE LIFE OF LEGENDARY NFL QUARTERBACK  
9 AND SPORTS TV AND RADIO PERSONALITY KEN STABLER.

11 WHEREAS, with utmost honor and respect we uplift and  
12 celebrate the tremendous life of legendary NFL Quarterback and  
13 sports TV and radio personality Ken Stabler; and

14 WHEREAS, the passing of Ken Stabler on July 8, 2015,  
15 at 69 years of age leaves a void in the lives of his loving  
16 family, many friends, and countless fans; and

17 WHEREAS, the Foley, Alabama, native, born December  
18 25, 1945, played for Bear Bryant at The University of Alabama,  
19 where he led the Crimson Tide to an undefeated season in 1966  
20 and was named an All-American in 1967; and

21 WHEREAS, during his NFL career, he played 10 seasons  
22 with the Oakland Raiders, where he earned his nickname, "The  
23 Snake"; he had the distinctions of being a four-time Pro Bowl  
24 selection, of being named the NFL's Most Valuable Player in  
25 1974, leading the Raiders to a Super Bowl victory in 1977, and

1       throwing for a total of 27,938 yards, 194 touchdowns, and just  
2       88 interceptions during his career; and

3               WHEREAS, following his NFL career, he worked as a  
4       color commentator for CBS' NFL telecasts and called Alabama  
5       games on the radio until 2009; and

6               WHEREAS, Ken Stabler was a valued citizen whose  
7       memory is deeply cherished in the hearts and minds of all  
8       those who were fortunate enough to know him, as well as his  
9       many fans; now therefore,

10              BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
11       HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That while grieving the death of  
12       Ken Stabler, we are extremely grateful for his abundant life,  
13       and we offer this resolution in highest tribute to his
