9 celebrate the tremendous life of legendary NFL Quarterback and  
10 sports TV and radio personality Ken Stabler; and

11 WHEREAS, the passing of Ken Stabler on July 8, 2015,  
12 at 69 years of age leaves a void in the lives of his loving  
13 family, many friends, and countless fans; and

14 WHEREAS, the Foley, Alabama, native, born December  
15 25, 1945, played for Bear Bryant at The University of Alabama,  
16 where he led the Crimson Tide to an undefeated season in 1966  
17 and was named an All-American in 1967; and

18 WHEREAS, during his NFL career, he played 10 seasons  
19 with the Oakland Raiders, where he earned his nickname, "The  
20 Snake"; he had the distinctions of being a four-time Pro Bowl  
21 selection, of being named the NFL's Most Valuable Player in  
22 1974, leading the Raiders to a Super Bowl victory in 1977, and  
23 throwing for a total of 27,938 yards, 194 touchdowns, and just  
24 88 interceptions during his career; and

1           WHEREAS, following his NFL career, he worked as a  
2 color commentator for CBS' NFL telecasts and called Alabama  
3 games on the radio until 2009; and

4           WHEREAS, Ken Stabler was a valued citizen whose  
5 memory is deeply cherished in the hearts and minds of all  
6 those who were fortunate enough to know him, as well as his  
7 many fans; now therefore,

8           BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
9 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That while grieving the death of  
10 Ken Stabler, we are extremely grateful for his abundant life,  
11 and we offer this resolution in highest tribute to his  
12 inspiring legacy, as well as in heartfelt sympathy to his  
13 family and friends.
