26 Corps of Engineers (USACE), which is headquartered in

30 leadership and staff positions throughout his career at the

34 success led him to key developmental assignments in the 36th  
35 Engineer Brigade at Fort Hood and in Afghanistan; he also  
36 served as the Aide-de-Camp for the USACE Commanding General
