9 WHEREAS, F. Taylor Noggle, Jr., was born August 17,
10 1945, in Augusta, Georgia. He attended public schools,
11 graduating from Louisville Academy High School in 1963. He
12 received his Bachelor of Science Degree in Chemistry from
13 Georgia Southern College in June of 1968. He received his
14 Master of Science Degree from Auburn University of Montgomery
15 in 1977.

16 WHEREAS, he began his career in Forensic Sciences
17 with the United States Army Criminal Investigation Laboratory
18 at Fort Gordon, Georgia, from February 1969 through November
19 1970 and was awarded the Army Commendation Medal for
20 Meritorious Service during this assignment.

21 WHEREAS, Mr. Noggle began employment with the
22 Alabama Department of Toxicology and Criminal Investigation on
23 January 6, 1971, later to be known as the Alabama Department
24 of Forensic Sciences. He held many positions while employed
25 with the department but worked primarily as a Drug Chemist.

1 During his career, he authored and co-authored approximately
2 90 articles in various scientific publications in conjunction
3 with the Auburn University School of Pharmacy. He also held
4 several administrative positions as Auburn Laboratory Director
5 and Drug Chemistry Coordinator and served as the statewide
6 Deputy Director until September 2002.

7 WHEREAS, on September 1, 2002, F. Taylor Noggle was
8 appointed as Interim Director of the Alabama Department of
9 Forensic Sciences and on December 17, 2002, he was appointed
10 permanent Director by Attorney General Bill Pryor until his
11 retirement on October 31, 2006.

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Noggle had many professional
13 affiliations and served as Vice President and President of the
14 Southern Association of Forensic Scientists.

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
16 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Auburn Laboratory of the
17 Alabama Department of Forensic Sciences shall be known as the
18 F. Taylor Noggle, Jr., Laboratory in honor of and in
19 appreciation for the distinguished service and leadership of
20 this outstanding individual.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the appropriate
22 officials are requested to identify and display the newly
23 designated building in accordance with the provisions of this
24 resolution.
