5 NAMING A PORTION OF HIGHWAY 31 IN ESCAMBIA COUNTY
6 THE SERGEANT WILLIAM WAYNE SEAY MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

8 WHEREAS, Sergeant William Wayne Seay was born in
9 Brewton, Alabama, on October 24, 1948; he died during combat
10 on August 25, 1986, in TayNinh, Vietnam; he served with
11 distinction in the U. S. Army and was posthumously awarded the
12 Congressional Medal of Honor for his heroism and gallantry in
13 saving the lives of his fellow soldiers; and

14 WHEREAS, Sergeant William Wayne Seay was on a
15 resupply mission with ammunition and supplies when his convoy
16 was ambushed; in addition to killing enemy soldiers with his
17 rifle, he twice returned armed enemy grenades to the North
18 Vietnamese position; his heroic actions saved the lives of his
19 fellow soldiers before he was mortally wounded by a sniper's
20 bullet; and

21 WHEREAS, the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 7016 in
22 Atmore, Alabama, has requested the naming of a portion of
23 Highway 31 in his memory; Sergeant William Wayne Seay served
24 his country with honor and distinction, and it is appropriate
25 and desirable to memorialize his life and his dedicated

1 service to the citizens of Alabama and the United States; now
2 therefore,

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
4 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in memory of Sergeant William
5 Wayne Seay we declare that a portion of Highway 31 in Escambia
6 County between Brewton and Flomaton be named the Sergeant
7 William Wayne Seay Memorial Highway.

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the appropriate
9 officials be requested to place and maintain signs or markers
10 as provided in this resolution.
