12 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., had as a great civil rights
13 leader; and

14 WHEREAS, the Legislature supports designating as a
15 memorial parkway a portion of Highway 431 in Gadsden, Alabama,
16 from the Attalla city limits to the Glencoe city limits in
17 honor of the late Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.; and

18 WHEREAS, the Legislature considers it a great
19 privilege and honor to install Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.,
20 Memorial Parkway signs on Meighan Boulevard in the City of
21 Gadsden, Alabama; now therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
23 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the portion of United States
24 Highway 431 in the City of Gadsden is designated as the Dr.
25 Martin Luther King, Jr., Memorial Parkway, and the appropriate

1 authorities are encouraged to erect and maintain signs and
2 markers specifying this designation of honor.
