5 URGING THE GOVERNOR TO IMPLEMENT THE PAPERWORK
6 REDUCTION COMMITTEE CREATED IN ACT 2001-475.

8 WHEREAS, as expressed by the Legislature in Act 9 2001-475, 2001 Regular Session, now appearing as Section 10 16-16B-11, Code of Alabama 1975, the excessive paperwork 11 required of teachers and other public education employees 12 hinders the prime responsibility of public education: The 13 education of the children of Alabama; and

14 WHEREAS, excessive and time-consuming reporting 15 requirements levied on school systems requires automation in 16 order for timely reporting to occur; the excessive paperwork 17 required of teachers has become more burdensome since the 18 initial creation of the committee, and that teachers continue 19 to not have adequate time to prepare lesson plans or to devote 20 individual attention to those students who require special 21 assistance; and

22 WHEREAS, the Legislature created the Paperwork 23 Reduction Committee in Act 2001-475, to study the paperwork 24 required of public school employees and prepare a report to 25 the State Superintendent of Education and the Legislature on how to reduce and automate that paperwork for the benefit of education; to date this committee has not been implemented, and the intent of the Legislature has not been accomplished; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH 5 6 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Governor and the Alabama Education Association are strongly urged to appoint members to 7 8 the Paperwork Reduction Committee and the Governor is further urged to implement and administer all required duties and 9 responsibilities included in Act 2001-475, including a report 10 11 to the State Superintendent of Education and the Legislature 12 on how to effectively reduce and automate teacher paperwork for the benefit of education. 13

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be provided to the Governor and the Executive Director of the Alabama Education Association, so that the strong sentiments of this body may be known.
