10	and medical laboratories, Alabama's biotechnology industry is
11	rising to the challenge of unmet medical needs; investment in
12	biotechnology innovation will successfully create health and

14	the nation, add high-quality jobs, and reverse the
15	skyrocketing costs of health care; and
16	WHEREAS, each year, Alabama is among national
17	leaders in bioscience patents showcasing the state's dynamic
