11 WHEREAS, it is a distinct privilege to extend
12 highest commendation to The Boeing Company, which has
13 contributed to the Space Launch System, NASA's most powerful
14 rocket ever built, the backbone for a permanent human presence
15 in deep space; the rocket's first Boeing-built core stage has
16 been delivered to Kennedy Space Center; and

17 WHEREAS, The Boeing Company is the largest aerospace
18 company in the State of Alabama and one of the largest
19 employers; Boeing employees and products have powered giant
20 leaps in human space exploration; now Boeing will be part of
21 landing the first woman and first person of color on the moon
22 and the sustainable exploration of more of the lunar surface
23 than ever before; NASA's Space Launch System is the
24 technologically advanced, heavy-lift rocket that will get us
25 there; and

26 WHEREAS, The Boeing Company's Space Launch System
27 program is located in Huntsville, Alabama, and is responsible

1 for the design, development, testing, and manufacture of the
2 core and upper stages of the Space Launch System moon rocket,
3 as well as the avionics for the nation's next-generation,
4 human-rated rocket to transport people and cargo into deep
5 space; and

6 WHEREAS, Boeing employees in Alabama support several
7 space programs, including the Space Launch System, Starliner,
8 and International Space Station; and

9 WHEREAS, the Boeing Company has shown a continuing
10 commitment to strengthening and benefitting our state and
11 nation, while helping to provide the means to a sustainable
12 presence on the moon, and soon, on Mars; now therefore,

13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
14 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in recognition of its
15 significant and enduring contributions, The Boeing Company is
16 congratulated upon its contributory impact to NASA's Space
17 Launch System, and this resolution is offered to The Boeing
