8 WHEREAS, it is a distinct privilege to extend
9 highest commendation to The Boeing Company, which has

13 been delivered to Kennedy Space Center; and

18 landing the first woman and first person of color on the moon

2 as well as the avionics for the nation's next-generation,

4 space; and

5 WHEREAS, Boeing employees in Alabama support several
6 space programs, including the Space Launch System, Starliner,
7 and International Space Station; and

8 WHEREAS, the Boeing Company has shown a continuing
9 commitment to strengthening and benefitting our state and
10 nation, while helping to provide the means to a sustainable
11 presence on the moon, and soon, on Mars; now therefore,

12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
13 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in recognition of its
14 significant and enduring contributions, The Boeing Company is
15 congratulated upon its contributory impact to NASA's Space
